Sunday October 3rd 1858

Began with strong breeze and clear weather from the E. ship heading to the S. and for cable super. later on and for most of the day in sight middle part strong breeze at the part spoke the

Latitude 22.48. S.
Longitude 157.38. E.

Monday October 4th

Began with strong breeze and squally weather from the E. ship heading to the S. the men were in morning middle and later part of the day we were with the ship in a bad harbor being out with the men in for 4 weeks since - and later part

Latitude 23.12. S.
Longitude 157.15. E.

Tuesday October 5th

Began with strong breeze and squally weather from the E. ship heading to the S. E. employed in ship's work middle part much the same latter part same a sail clearing to the S. the

Latitude 24.44. S.
Longitude 157.00. E.

Wednesday October 6th 1858

Began with light breeze and pleasant from the S. ship heading to the E. employed in ship's work middle and later part released from service and later the ship and later part of the day we were with the ship in a bad harbor being out with the men in for 4 weeks since - and later part

Latitude 24.55. S.
Longitude 156.50. E.

Thursday October 7th

Began with moderate breeze and clear weather from the S. ship heading to the E. employed in ship's work middle part pleasant latter part employed in repairing the ship. Latitude 25.05. S.

Longitude 156.00. E.

Friday October 8th

Began with moderate breeze and pleasant weather from the S. ship heading to the S. E. employed in repairing the ship. middle part pleasant latter part ship of the ship's work. Latitude 25.32. S.

Longitude 155.40. E.

Saturday October 9th

Began with strong breeze and pleasant weather from the E. ship heading to the S. E. employed in ship's work middle and later part much the same.

Latitude 26.15. S.
Longitude 155.10. E.
