

Bark Canton Packet's Log Book.

Monday March 18th 1861

Begins with moderate breezes and pleasant from the S.W. ship heading to the E.S.E. all drawing sail set nothing in sight middle and latter part the same Latitude 39.20.S.

Tuesday March 19th

Begins with moderate breezes and rain from the N.E.W. ship heading to the N.E. under short sail nothing in sight middle and latter part the same Latitude 38.39.S.
Longitude 40.30.W.

Wednesday March 20th

Begins with moderate breezes and haze from the S.W. course S.E. all drawing sail set employed in ships duty at 7 P.M. the wind moved to the S.W. set the studding sails middle and latter part much the same Latitude 37.10.S.
Longitude 41.58.W.

Thursday March 21st

Begins with light breezes and pleasant from the S. ship heading to the E.S.E. all sail set employed in ships duty middle part wind to the W. course S.E. latter part fresh breezes and squall from the S.W. course S.E. Latitude 35.38.S.
Longitude 40.10.W.

Friday March 22^d 1861

Begins with a brisk gale from the S.W. with heavy squalls course S.E. under double reefed topsails and foresail middle and latter part more moderate all sail set course S.E. got sent up the fore topmast Latitude 33.17.S.
must Longitude 38.16.W.

Saturday March 23^d

Begins with moderate breezes and pleasant from the S.W. course S.E. all sail set employed in ships duty middle part wind moving to the S. latter part wind S.E. ship heading to the S.W. Latitude 32.30.S.
Longitude 37.55.W.

Sunday March 24th

Begins with moderate breezes and pleasant from the S.W. ship heading to the E. middle part wind freshening up latter part blowing fresh from the N. under a double reefed main topsail and fore sail at noon a heavy squall from the S. close reefed the main topsail Latitude 32.35.S.
Longitude 37.10.W.

Monday March 25th

Begins with strong breezes and haze from the S.W. course S.E. under moderate sail middle part wind W. latter part set up the fore topmast yard and painted it Latitude 31.00.S.
Longitude 35.29.W.
