

Bark Canton Packets Log Book

Tuesday March 26th 1861

Begins with moderate breezes and pleasant from the S.W. course S.W.E. all sail set employed in ships duty middle part the same latter part saw a sail Latitude 29.33 S. Longitude 34.50 W.

Wednesday March 27th

Begins with moderate breezes and pleasant from the S.W. course S.W.E. employed in ships duty middle and latter part much the same Latitude 27.43 S. Longitude 34.30 W.

Thursday March 28th

Begins with moderate breezes and pleasant from the S.E. course S.E. employed in ships duty spoke the Gay packet of N. B. Fare 51 months out 1800 up middle and latter part the same Latitude 28.32 S. Longitude 34.08 W.

Friday March 29th

Begins with moderate breezes and pleasant from the E.S.E. course S.W.E. in company with the Gay packet middle and latter part pleasant Latitude 28.24 S. Longitude 33.50 W.

Saturday March 30th 1861

Begins with moderate breezes and squally from the E. ship heading to the S.W.E. employed in ships duty sails in sight middle and latter part the same Latitude 26.30 S. Longitude 34.08 W.

Sunday March 31st

Begins with light breezes and pleasant from the N.E. ship heading to the S.W.E. employed in ships duty boarded the ship Vizint of Boston from Liverpool bound to Calicut middle and latter part pleasant Latitude 24.25 S. Longitude 34.00 W.

Monday April 1st 1861

Begins with moderate breezes and pleasant from the E.S.E. course S.E. employed in ships duty several vessels in sight middle and latter part much the same Latitude 20.38 S. Longitude 34.08 W.

Tuesday April 2^d

Begins with moderate breezes and pleasant from the E.S.E. course S.W.E. employed in ships duty middle and latter part much the same Latitude 19.10 S. Longitude 33.50 W.
