Wednesday April 3rd 1861

Begins with moderate breezes and pleasant from the E. course S.E. employed in ships duty middle and latter part much the same
Latitude 17.02.5.
Longitude 33.58.5.

Thursday April 4th

Begins with moderate breezes and pleasant from the E.E. course S.E. & S. all sail set several sail in sight middle and latter part the same
Latitude 15.04.5.
Longitude 33.57.5.

Friday April 5th

Begins with moderate breezes and pleasant from the E. ship heading to the S.E. all sail set employed in ships duty middle part the same latter part cleaning iron work aloft
Latitude 12.48.5.
Longitude 33.21.5.

Saturday April 6th

Begins with moderate breezes and pleasant from the S.E. course S.E. employed in cleaning iron work middle and latter part much the same
Latitude 10.24.5.
Longitude 33.13.5.

Sunday April 7th 1861

Begins with moderate trades and squalls from the E.S.E. course S.E. employed in ships duty middle and latter part much the same
Latitude 8.03.5.
Longitude 33.40.5.

Monday April 8th

Begins with moderate trades and pleasant from the S.E. course S.E. & S. 1 sail in sight middle part at 3 P.M. saw a sail latter part the same
Latitude 5.25.5.
Longitude 33.56.5.

Tuesday April 9th

Begins with moderate trades and pleasant from the S.E. course S.E. employed in fitting ship for home middle and latter part much the same
Latitude 3.30.5.
Longitude 34.28.5.

Wednesday April 10th

Begins with light trades and pleasant from the S.E. course S.E. employed in fitting ship middle and latter part much the same
Latitude 1.50.5.
Longitude 35.00.5.
