Commenced with moderate winds from the E. by S. and fine pleasant weather Ship Company employed in various acts of Ship duty. Middle Part
broad winches and plowpoint Lutter like the former ship Lat. 66. 14. 25
Friday July 2. 1833. Commenced with strong winds from E. S. and square
the ship under reefed top sail at 2 PM broke the Ship Boarding gunward
of Palmonth 400 lbs 10 Months out. Middle Part strong winches and plowpoint
Lutter Part strong winches ship under 2 reefed top sail Lat. 66. 14. 33 S.

3. Begin with fine clear pleasant weather winds from the South S. E. & moderate with all. All hands variously employed Cooper in Coppermine Rd. Mission-
ary's. 28. Midnight Home ship to North. Latter much like the former Land. 4. 41. Long 103° 30'.
5. Sunday July 14th 1853. Begin with fine weather winds from S. E. Mission Post
moderate and fine Latter like the former Land by Obs. 5. 16 S long 110° 40' 42' -
