NNW NW First part a strong gale from the NW with a heavy swell on and 2nd strong gale with passing squalls with some rain

NW NNE First part strong gales and a heavy swell on 1st wind and weather the same 2nd more moderate

NW NNW NNE First part moderate breeze and clear 2nd strong breeze with rain and fog saw two ships

W NE These 24 hours strong breeze and clear weather saw a schooner and a sail and several timbers

NNW NW First part strong breeze with thick rainy weather saw a sail and plenty of timbers on 1st light breeze 2nd strong breeze with rain and ends so

NNW NNW NNE First part strong breeze at 2 PM more moderate on and 2nd light breeze saw a Brig
