6 N 6 S W Light breezes the ship lying off and on at St Vincent

6 N 6 S W Moderate breezes on N wind hauls to S 1/2 S P squally with rain accompanied by thunders and lightning saw two sails

6 N 6 S W Fresh breeze and squally with rain spoke the North Isabella small saw the Sappho to the land S 1/2 calm three sail in sight
