10th 75 76 S 6 S 6 1 E 75 76

Begins with strong breeze from S 6 W and cloudy headed from S 6 E to S 6 W in company with the Barclay L.P. saw two sails west

11th 75 76 S 6 S 6 1 E 75 76 Strong breeze and cloudy at 8 PM hauled to W 6 N and at 10 PM wind and weather the same saw a sail steering N W

12th 75 76 S 6 S 6 1 E 75 76 Comes in with a strong breeze from S 6 E and cloudy current not so strong as it has been on 10 fresh breeze with passing squalls at 10 moderate breeze with fair weather and ends so this day crossed the Equator

13th 75 76 S 6 S 6 1 E 75 76 Comes in with a moderate breeze and fine weather exchanged signal with an English Bark steering North and L.P. bisk tracks and fair weather experienced a strong current setting to the N 6 saw 2 black birds

14th 75 76 S 6 S 6 1 E 75 76 Comes in with fresh tracks and fine weather middle part fresh tracks wind veered to S 6 E and at 10 L.P. bisk breeze and fine weather and ends so saw Blackfish

Friday 78 77 S 6 S 6 1 E 75 76 First part bisk tracks and fine weather on 10 fresh breeze and squalls with rain L.P. Moderate breeze and fine weather and ends so

Saturday 78 78 S 6 S 6 1 E 75 76 First part of these 24 hours moderate breeze and fair weather on 10 fresh tracks and squalls with rain the wind dropped away to a perfect calm during the continuance of the rain L.P. fresh breeze and fine weather and ends so experienced little or no current
