 16 per compass On and 10 P Moderate breeze  
 steered 16 by 16 saw two sail

First part strong breeze and cloudy  
 16 by 16 a large swell running Middle part  
 strong breeze and squally 16 P strong  
 gale and squally with a large sea  
 saw sun 1/2 h

Strong breeze and clear the wind inclining  
 to 16 W at 4 P M none headwinds the wind  
 heaved to SW a Bark in sight On P  
 wind heaved 16 better Part calm bent  
 a fine 16 sail and 16

First Part light air from 16 and fine  
 weather a Bark in sight Middle part  
 light variable breeze 16 P fresh breeze  
 and ends so

comes in with a fresh breeze and cloudy  
 with indications of more wind On  
 P strong breeze and squally took in sail  
 16 P strong breeze from N with fog at  
 M A No more moderate set the main  
 course and 16 still continues foggy

comes in with fresh breeze and thick  
 fog at 1 P M shook the keels out of the  
 16 by 16 at 6 made all sail On P  
 at 1 hour and 30 minutes 16 the wind  
 heaved to S 16 P fresh breeze and cloudy  
 with passing squalls and ends so

comes in with a fresh breeze from  
 S and inclining to the S 16 at 7 P M  
 the wind 16 by 16 On P at 2 16 would  
 heaved 16 by 16 16 strong breeze with  
 thick fog thickened twice ends with  
 fog
