Thursday Dec 2 12.49 112.00	82	81	SE				Moderate breeze and fine weather. At 4.30 PM lowered for sperm whales. Struck and killed three. At 5 PM cut in the whales and made sail at 11. At 1 PM saw more whales going quick to windward.
