Sight breeze and fine weather
 At 8 made the Island of Sunboon
 bearing N 6 Sombock bore N
 employed in setting up hoops
 for water stored in for the
 land the wind hauled to N W
 with rain

Sight breeze and fine weather
 At 4 PM got the Anchors of the
 Bow and bent the chains at 7 o'clock
 PM entered the straits of Allaf
 on a light air and calm working in
 under the Sombock spore at 10
 AM came to Anchor in Bally
 Roads with the flag staff bearing
 N N W in 11 fathoms water

Employed in stowing down oil
 and watering

Employed in watering sent
 Archer Fowler the Boatsteer
 who has been sick a long time ashore

Employed in watering

Employed in recruiting ship
 and stowing water one watch
 ashore on liberty

Recruiting ship one watch
 ashore on liberty the Bark Ellen
 of Edger town come to Anchor
 & discharged and paid off Archer
 Fowler and furnished him as
 good accommodations as the place
 afforded

At day light got under way
 with a strong breeze and squally
 weather with indications of heavy
 wind at 10 AM blowing strong started
 sail the bar stood 29.40
