Saturday Feb 12th

Light breeze from NW to N and
fair weather Bour bore SE
Dulla Bep bore N 4 E at 8
calm the tide in light
Lat 2.28 South

Sunday Feb 13th

Light breeze from N lower
for Blackbird to no purpose
On and a fresh breeze from
Dulla Bep bore NW dist 11 miles
Lat 2.11 S Long 126.23 East

Monday Feb 14th

A strong breeze from N head
to NE by Major bore E by N
beating into the Mollucca Sea
experienced a strong current
setting S 4 E 5 knots per hour
Lat 2.07 S Long 127.17 East

Tuesday Feb 15th

Strong breeze from S to NW
beating to NE and N to N 4 E
beating against a 5 knot current
Gomonga and Ob Major in
sight at 3 P M. For 4 P M
going quick to NW but without
success Lat 1.47 S Long 127.18 E

Wednesday Feb 16th

Strong breeze from NW to head
to NW by Major Gomonga
and Little Pulu Ob in sight
Lat 1.48 S Long 127.18 E

Thursday Feb 17th

Light breeze from NW by Little
Pulu Ob Major and Gomonga
in sight at 3 P M. For 4 P M
warp of ordered Eekiel Trask
and Antoine Grotto the Cook to
be seized upon the rigging for
fighting they being the second
time he has been guilty of
the same offence I forgave the
first time telling him not
to do so again if he did I
would punish him
Lat 1.47 S Long 126.57 E

Friday Feb 18th

Moderate breeze from NW by
at 3 P M brooked for the before
mentioned whos but without
success at sunset I released
the Cook and sent him to his
duty I also offered to release
Trask if he would promise
to do better in future his re-
ply was that he would strike the
Cook or any other under the same
circumstance I then confined
him by putting him in Irons
Lat 1.32 S Long 126.05 E

Saturday Feb 19th

A strong breeze from NW to head
NW all of the Dulla Islands in
sight. Released Trask on his
promising to do better in future
the wind hauled S 4 E strong
NW to saw the Island of Celebes
bearing S dist 60 miles
Lat 1.34 S Long 125.04 E

Sunday Feb 20th

Light breeze from S 4 E at 8 P M
the wind hauled suddenly in
a squall to NW. A strong
breeze and squally with rain
at 11 A M spoke the Bark Glend
Smith of N B. had 9 months 2000
the ship James Allen in sight
