

Bark Active Thos Morrison Master

Monday March 7th

Light breeze from NNE morning
calm till 4 pm then N to NW
and at 8 light airs lat 11.13 N

Tuesday March 8th

Light airs from NNE at 2 pm
came to anchor in Keema Harbour
in 11 fathoms of water where
I found my old shipmate Capt
Huyford of the Bark Ellen of
Colchester has taken 100 bbls of
oil since we parted at Bala Sea
sent my men ashore on Liberty
and recruiting ship

Wednesday March 13th

At 7 AM got under way with
a good breeze and passed
off of the Bay I shipped
three Manilla Men and
turned the Stevedore Howard
for breaking his liberty and
penal he not being in a state
to perform his duty when it
was necessary that I should have
his services

Thursday March 14th

Strong breeze from NW and
a strong current setting S W
steered SE in PM passed Dyfod
S P lowered for Sp Whales
Lat 10.30 S. Lat 10.30 S. bearing S E
dist 25 miles Ternate Island
struck and killed one and
got a Boat stove

Friday March 15th

Saw the Whale alongside and
cut him in S P fresh meat
from it and squally with rain
lat 10.30 N

In The Mollucca Passage

Wednesday March 16th

Calm employed in boiling
Ternate Tidors Moschian and
several other of the Mollucca
Islands in sight lat 10.36 N

Thursday March 17th

Light breeze from NE with rain
PM and at 6 PM strong breeze lat 10

Friday March 18th

Light breeze from N headed NW
at 2 PM lowered for Sp Whales
but did not get up to them
as they were going quick to windward
PM and at 6 PM strong breeze
lat 10.22 N long 126.35 East

Saturday March 19th

Strong breeze from N headed ENE
PM headed to N W wind NNE
clouds with fine weather the land
in sight lat 10.34 N long 125.58

Sunday March 20th

Strong breeze from N steered S
PM at 7 PM stopped off on shore
with short light S P spoke the
Bark Cleora she has taken 60 bbls
since we parted company

Monday March 21st

Strong breeze from N heading to
windward in company with the
Cleora lat 10.36 N long 126.34

Tuesday March 22nd

Light breeze from NNE headed
off and on shore in company
with the Cleora I lent Capt
Smith my cooper to split him
a couple of days current S W
4 knots an hour lat 10.36 S
long 126.37 E
