Monday May 23rd

83-85
Came in calm at 3 PM took
a light breeze from S steered
E S E on P light airs and calm
at intervals S P New Guinea dist
30 miles light breeze from S to
S S E steered E N E Lat 0.01 N Long 133.58

Tuesday May 24th

83-85
Light airs and fine weather
on P calm S P light breezes from
N and fine weather the land
dist 40 miles Lat 0.22 N Long 134.44

Wednesday May 25th

83-85
Light breeze and
fine weather on P calm S P
a light breeze from N headed
P S S New Guinea dist 40 miles
Lat By Obs 0.24 N

Thursday May 26th

83-85
Light variable at 1 hour and 20 m
PM saw Sp Whales breaching 10
miles off squally with rain
S P fresh breezes from N N to S W
and squally with rain

Friday May 27th

Moderate breezes from N headed
in for New Guinea saw the
Dorel Islands and Waigiese to
the W on P steered E S E S P
New Guinea dist 30 miles
Lat 0.24 N Long 133.44 E

Saturday May 28th

84-85
Came in with a strong breeze from
S W to W steered E on P light
showers of rain boughs with fine
weather saw Blackfish
Lat 0.39 N Long 132.15 East

Off New Guinea May 1853

Sunday May 29th

Began with a strong from E headed
S S E on P steered N N S P steered
West fine weather and end to
Lat 0.59 N Long 131.30 E

Monday May 30th

Came in with a moderate breeze
from E steered W at 2 PM made
the Asia Islands bearing W dist
20 miles on P passed between the
Asia and Dorel Islands saw light
on shore S P strong breezes and
squally with rain Lat 0.50 N by 12.50

Tuesday May 31st

Moderate breezes from E S E
with passing squalls at 4 PM
made the Island of Sangrai
dist 40 miles on P light breezes
steered S by W S P at sunrise
bore S dist 15 miles Gillolo and
Pulo Moar bore S W to W
I thought of anchoring to get
water but the wind and current
proving unfavourable I gave up the
idea and kept off

Wednesday June 1st

Began with moderate breezes from
E steered W and S W at sunset
gave bore to dist 25 miles saw a
ship on shore S P light breezes
Gillolo Pulo Pisang and the Dorel
Isles in sight saw Blackfish and
sulphur bottoms exchanged signals
with a Dutch man a war

Thursday June 2nd

Moderate breeze from S S E headed
S W the Dorel Isles in sight at 9
PM anchored of shore at 11 PM
in again at sunrise passed
the Misway Ledge the Dorel
Isles Gillolo Pulo Pisang Kikik
Saw the Pulo Gapes Tookison
Major Jaba Maja and Batehain
