Light airs and calm at intervals
cleaning ship at 4 PM took a light
breeze from NW with rain & P
wind from NW steamed 86

Pothopers, Hays and Gillolo in
sight Lat 1.47 N Long 126.30 E

Thursday June 9th

a fresh breeze from NW and thick
and rainy. Having had so much
weather I determined to run into
Ternate in the night it be-
neficial to see a doctor on acc-

of having three sick men I
running on I got upon a shoal
not laid down on my charts
the sounding were from no bottom
with 25 fathoms of line out to
6 and the next cast 3 I immediately
let go the anchor and lowered
a boat and sounded the way
off while the officers rock
getting the dredge ready we
dredged her off with very little
trouble it was calm during
the rest of the night at 8
it being still calm I took
a Boat and pulled up to the town

Friday June 10

At 5 PM came to anchor in
22 fathoms water sent the
to the Hospital

Saturday June 11 employed in

Monday June 13th a strong breeze

Tuesday June 14 took the men out
of the Hospital and got under
way with a light breeze
