Strong breeze N to NE and
squally weather steered NW by
wind S.W. Lat 4.00 N Long 120.19 E

Sunday July 3^d

Came in with a strong gale from
NW and heavy showers of rain
have too much a double reefed No
top sail on and S.P. more moderate
steered NE Lat 4.18 N Long 122.07 E

Monday July 4th

Came in with a strong breeze from
S and fine weather steered NE
on and S.P. moderate breezes and fair
weather and ends so
Lat By Obs 5.54 N Long 122.33 E

Tuesday July 5th

Came in with light breezes
from S to SE steered ENE on and
S.P. strong gales and squally with
rain and ends so current S.E.
Lat 5.48 N Long 124.04 E

Wednesday July 6th

These 24 hours strong gales from
NW to W made the Island of Mindanao
at Sunset Point Bambar
bore NW dist 30 miles ends weather
thick and squally

Thursday July 7th

Came in with thick squally weather
and heavy rain wind veering from
NE to W and continued so through
the night ends with fine weather
steered ENE Lat By Obs 4.49 North
Long By Chron 124.56 E

Friday July 8th

Came in with moderate breezes
from NW and fine weather
steered ENE on S.P. squally S.P. at
8 o'clock S.P. made Serengani or
Hummock Island bearing NE dist 30
Mindanao in sight Lat 5.18 N Long 125.30 E

Saturday July 9th

Strong breezes from NW and squally
throughout the 24 hours Mindanao
and the Serengani and Hummock
Isles in sight Lat 4.55 N

Sunday July 10th

Strong breezes from NW experienced
a strong current setting to SE seven
Islands in sight Sahigir bore SE
Lat 3.44 N Long 125.60 East

Monday July 11th

Came in with strong breezes and
squally with heavy showers of rain
steering NNE wind NW at 4 P.M.
piped the N end of Sanguia lapped
up and steered a short course &
Islands in sight we were boarded
by a canoe from one of the small
Isles with cocoa nuts on P strong
gales from the NW S.P. wind and
weather continued the same piped
Siow Tagolanda Bujuran and
saw Celebes to the S.W.

Tuesday July 12th

Came in with moderate breezes from
SW headed S.E. by wind at 4 P.M.
came up thick and squally took in
the light sails and double reefed
the top sails on P strong breezes
from N to NW squally with rain
S.P. strong gales from SW and S.W.
piped the Island of Mayo at 12
noon the Island of Ternate bore E
dist 20 miles Hiez, Tidore and
Gillolo in sight experienced a
strong current setting NE Lat 4.01 N

Wednesday July 13th

Strong gales from S steered NNE and
NE by S along the Gillolo shore
S.P. Gillolo North and Riou
in sight Lat 2.49 N
Long 128.40 E
