Moderate trades throughout and
fine weather headed by wind
the Adventure in sight
Lat By Obs 13.16 S Long 112.40 East

Sunday Oct 9th

A moderate breeze throughout the
24 hours and fine weather headed by
wind Lat 13.14 S Long 113.29 East

Monday Oct 10th

Light breezes from S.E. to S.S.E. and
fine weather headed S.W.
Lat 13.24 South Long 112.29 East

Tuesday Oct 11th

Moderate breezes from S.S.E. headed
S.W. S.P. strong breezes Lat 13.31 S
Long 111.38 E

Wednesday Oct 12th

Strong breezes from S.S.E. headed to
S.S.W. Lat 13.34 S Long 110.56 East

Thursday Oct 13th

Light breezes from S.S.E. all these

24 hours headed by wind Lat 13.13 South
Long By Chron 112.00 E

Tuesday Oct 18th

Light breezes from S.S.E. and fine weather
all these 24 hours saw a Merchantman
bound N.E. S.P. saw the Bark Adventure
12 miles to windward Whaling boat the
ship to windward Lat 12.58 S Long 112.35 E

Wednesday Oct 19th

Came in with a moderate breeze from
S.E. beating the ship to windward
at 3 P.M. passed the Bark Adventure
cutting in S.P. saw the A again whaling
Lat 13.10 South Long 112.20 East

Thursday Oct 20th

Moderate breezes from S.S.E. and fine
weather saw the whales ahead going
to leeward, lowered the Boat but
saw nothing more of the whales
which I attribute solely to not having
any one who understands keeping
ship. I suppose that I shall be obliged
to keep ship myself which if I do will
be a disadvantage to the voyage

Friday Oct 21st

Strong breezes throughout from S.E.
headed by wind Saw the Adventure
and a Merchant ship bound to the S

hours headed by wind passed the
Adventure steering West
Lat By Obs 13.37 S Long By Chron 112.09
