from S.E. and a heavy swell
headed by wind saw Blackfish
lowered two boats to no purpose
The Thermometer stood in air 82. Water 83

Friday Nov 4th

Fresh breezes from S.E. to S. and fair
weather headed by wind S.P. at sun
rise saw S.P. Whales going to windward
lowered but did not strike came
on board and worked the ship to
windward Lat 13.37 S Long 112.09 E

Saturday Nov 5th

Fresh breezes from S.E. at 1 o'clock
saw the Whales again to windward
lowered, struck and killed one
and took him alongside bent a
new fore sail S.P. cut in the whale

Sunday Nov 6th

Fresh breezes from S.E. and fair
weather headed by wind finished
boiling Therm air 81. Water 83
