

1853 *U.S. Active Thos Harrison Master*

Tuesday Nov 22nd

Fresh breezes from S E to S by East and fine weather headed N E by E 1/2 N and S E by wind on P squally with light showers of rain S P made the Island of Sumbawa bearing N dist 50 miles I find an error of thirty miles in my chronometer the ship being to the East of where the chron gives her Lat 9.57 S Long 115.17 True

Wednesday Nov 23rd

Calm with light airs at intervals throughout made but little head way the current setting to the East in shore and to the West off shore Lat By Obs 9.18 S Long 116.47 East

Thursday Nov 24th

Calm with light airs at intervals all these 24 hours close in with the Sumbawa coast Lat 9.14 S

Friday Nov 25th

Light airs throughout current E Lat 9.14 S

Saturday Nov 26th

At light breeze from N to S and fine weather steering for Allaps Straits on P entered the Straits At 6 o'clock A.M. the Peak on Lombok bore N N W the S W point of Sumbawa S E by S the S E end of Lombok bore N dist 1 mile at 8 hours and 20 minutes I took a boat and landed at Bally Town to see if I could procure some corn for the Hogs at 10 returned on board with what I could get and stowed down the Straits at noon passed through the narrows

Sunday Nov 27th

Fresh breezes from S W to S E day and during the night off Slaty Islands S P light air a sail in sight

1853 *On The Flores Sea*

Monday Nov 28th

Light breezes from W steered E 1/2 N Lombok Peak Sumbawa Delonada and Mayo in sight the other sail in sight I believed to be a Dutch man from Soerabaya bound to Amboina saw Killeps and Timboks Sgt 7.56 S Long 119.20 S I made the Peak on Gunung Appie 4663 feet high

Tuesday Nov 29th

Light breezes from S E and fine weather Sumbawa Gunung Appie Gilbante and Amodo in sight on P experienced a current setting to S E S P Flores and the Scheidam Islands in sight saw two sails Lat 7.59 S Long 121.20

Wednesday Nov 30th

Light land and sea breezes throughout the 24 hours steered East S E to Flores and Rusa Rajai in sight saw two sails S P Rusa Linguate in sight saw grampuses Lat 8.09 S Long 121.45 East

Thursday Dec 1st

Light land and sea breezes all these 24 hours at 6 P.M. passed within a mile of Rusa Linguate on steered E 1/2 N S P at sunrise Flores Head bore S E by E dist 15 miles Lat By Obs 7.49 S Long 122.35 East

Friday Dec 2nd

Came in with light airs from N E and fine weather on and S P calm at sunrise Pulo Comba bore East dist 40 miles Flores Head bore S saw grampuses Lat 7.44 S Long 122.51 E

Saturday Dec 3rd

Light airs throughout steered N saw Timboks and grampuses the thermograph at 87 in air water 88 in the sun at 120 Lat 7.07 S Long 123.13 East
