

1854 Bark Active Thos Morrison Master

Sunday January 1st 1854

Fresh breezes from NNE and fair weather steered a shore course between the S & E and E & S at 3 PM passed Comond Lat 11° 53' South

Monday Jan 2nd

Light airs throughout these 24 hours trying to get in to Gaspar Strait saw a sail suppose her to be the Cleora Lat 0° 53' S

Tuesday Jan 3rd

Light airs at 4 P a fresh breeze from E at sunset in the str. On P a fresh breeze. 4 P calm the Cleora in sight sending down her Main Top Mast to repair Trussel trees and cross trees 3 Chokees Rernaldo Ferniquez alias Honery L. Rodgers for refusing to draw water and clenching the 2^d Mate Lat 0° 16' South

Wednesday Jan 4th

Light breezes from NNE to ENE. Gaby and Gillolo in sight saw the Cleora employed in trying to get in to the Gaspar Strait at 9 PM tacked to N by E the wind N by W L.P. passed between Gaby and Pulo Moar Lat By Ob 0° 09' North

Thursday Jan 5th

A light breeze from N by E and fine weather steered N and N by W at 12 past 12 tacked to N by W L.P. Gillolo and the Catharine Isles in sight saw a breach Lat 1° 04' N Long 128° 4'

Cruising Off Gillolo

Friday Jan 6th Fresh breezes from

NNE the before mentioned beaches proved to be off whales bound E at 1.30 PM lowered 4 Boats the S and W Boats struck and killed 2 at 4 got both whales alongside cut in one on P started the try works & P cut in the other whale the current swept us in to the Bay of Opa Lat 0° 10' N Long 128° 35' E

Saturday Jan 7th

Light variable breezes and calm at intervals at 2 PM passed within a few ships length of a rock apparently not more than two feet under water tacked ship and sounded in 10 fathoms of water a small round Island off shore bearing E by N dist 8 miles another flat Island bearing ENE and the Isle in shore bearing W by S according to my charts I suppose they shall be the Canton Packet shall employed in clearing up on and L.P. wind light and variable the ship in the East side of Oda Bay Lat 0° 52' N

Sunday Jan 8th

Light breezes from W and fine weather steered N and N by W employed in boiling on P cooled down L.P. calm Gillolo in sight Lat 1° 08' North

Monday Jan 9th

Calm with airs from S at intervals throughout these 24 hours Gillolo in sight Lat By Ob 1° 28' North
