Tuesday Jan 24th

Strong breezes from N to N.E. and squally with rain stowing down and breaking out the latter. Hauled Lat 12.55 N Long 135.12 E

Wednesday Jan 25th

Whale breezes from N.E. to N.W. and squally at intervals finished stowing of the latter. Hauled Lat 11.40 N Long 135.40

Thursday Jan 26th

Light breezes from N.E. and fair weather headed N.W. to N. at 8 A.M. however for 30 miles going quickly to S.E. apparently galleys struck and killed one at 11 o'clock took him alongside and got ready to cut in Lat 12.5 N Long 136.00 East

Friday Jan 27th

Light breezes from N and fine weather cut in the whale and started the try works Lat 1.34 N Long 135.47 E

Saturday Jan 28th

Light breezes from N to N.E. and fine weather employed in trying out at 9 o'clock P.M. cooked down the P. fresh breezes Lat 1.49 North Long 135.40 E

Sunday Jan 29th

Fresh breezes from N to N.E. and fine weather all these 24 hours headed by wind Lat 2.03 N Long 135.35

Monday Jan 30th

Fresh breezes from N to N.E. and fair weather headed N.W. on one tack and east on the other a strong current setting S.W. Lat 12.50 N Long 134.40 East

New Bedford Off New Guinea

Tuesday Jan 31st

Whale breezes from N to N.E. and fair weather all these 24 hours headed N.W. on one tack and E on the other. Current Lat 3.14 N

Wednesday February 1st

Comes in with a light breeze from N and fine weather headed E by N. On 6 fresh breezes from N.E. to S.P. were ship headed to N.W. and squally Lat 4.16 N Long 134.60 East

Thursday Feb 2nd

Comes in with a fresh breeze from N.E. inclining to E with indications of squally weather. S.P. strong breezes from E and squally with heavy rain and wind so Lat by Estimation 5.20 N Long 135.20 East

Friday Feb 3rd

Comes in with strong breezes from N.N.E. to E and a heavy squall of wind and rain headed from E to S.E. by wind and the same Lat 5.09 N Long 136.18 East

Saturday Feb 4th

Comes in with a strong breeze from N.E. and fair weather headed E.S.E. by wind made sail on and S.V. wind and weather continued the same and with fine weather Lat 4.30 North Long 137.49 East

Sunday Feb 5th

Fresh breezes from N.E. and fine weather at 12 hours and 30 minutes P.M. tacked ship headed N.N.W. on and S.P. wind fresh Lat 5.35 N Long

Monday Feb 6th Light breezes throughout and fine weather repaired sails and sent a New Main Top sail Lat 5.07 N Long 138.10 East
