N.W. dist 10 or 12 miles from which
we saw an extensive reef extending
from the east side of the Eastern
most Island about one mile to
the other Island dist 7 or 8 miles
to the Westward of it ends with strong
trades and fair weather Lat 8.09 North
Long By Obs

Wednesday Feb 22

Strong trades from E.N.E. to E by N
and fair weather headed N and N
by E by wind per compass on P strong
trades with passing squalls L.P. more
Moderate ends fine weather
Lat By Obs 10.22 North Long By Obs

Thursday Feb 23rd

Came in with a fresh breeze from
E.N.E. and cloudy streak N.W. by W
wind on P streak N by W 1/2 to S.P.
at 9 hours and 30 A.M. made the Is.
of Guam one of the Ladrones or
Marian Group bearing N by E
dist 35 miles hauled up by the
wind and headed for the Island
Lat By Obs 13.05 N Long 144.14 E

New Bedford In Rumatic Bay Guam
Friday Feb 24

Came in with Moderate breeze
from E.N.E. to E and fine weather
steering in for the land at 5 o'clock
P.M. a Pilot at 7.30 came to
Anchor in Rumatic Bay in 9 1/2 fathoms
water with the Flag Staff on the
Port bearing N.W. by N

Saturday Feb 25th

Employed in watering and
wooding and painting and repairing
ship till March 1

Wednesday March 1st

Strong trades throughout the
24 hours at 8 A.M. got under way
in company with the Alice
Frazier and Irish Swift

Thursday March 2nd

Strong trades all these 24
hours headed N.W. by wind
the Alice Frazier in company
employed in making a stock
for the Ladrones Anchor having
broken the stock in Rumatic
experienced a strong current
setting S.W. Lat 14.58 Long 143.18 E

Friday March 3

Moderate breezes throughout
these 24 hours and light
showers of rain the A.F. in
company finished the Anchor
stock Lat 15.10 142.35 E

Saturday March 4

Came in with light breezes
from N.W. to N the A.F.
in company L.P. strong breezes
Lat 15.35 N Long 144.67 East

Sunday March 5

Strong breezes from N.W. all these
24 hours headed N.W. the
Alice Frazier in company
Lat 16.10 N Long 139.25 E
