Moderate gales from NNE and cloudy showers NW the Alice Frasier in company split the Lib Lat 18.11 N Long 138.28 E

Tuesday March 14th

Moderate breezes from NNE headed NW L P strong gales the Alice Frasier in company Lat 19.53 N Long 137.35 East

Wednesday March 15th

Strong breezes from ENE headed N Lat 4 P M spoke the Alice Frasier Lat 21.11 N Long 136.48 E

Thursday March 16th

Came in with strong breezes and fair weather ended with fine weather the A & I in company Lat 22.33 N Long 136.43 E

Friday March 17th

Light breezes from ENE headed N L P wind shifted NE the Alice Frasier in company Lat 23.32 N Long 135.32 East

Saturday March 18th

Moderate breezes from N to NNE headed by wind lost sight of the Alice Frasier Lat 23.58 Long 135

Sunday March 19th

Strong breezes all these 24 hours and squally with rain NW

Monday March 20th

L Moderate gale and cloudy wind NNE headed NW Lat 26.19 N Long 137.27 E

Tuesday March 21st

Strong breezes throughout and thick rainy weather wind from NNE to ENE Lat 27.46 Long 138.11 E

Wednesday March 22nd

Strong breezes from SSE throughout and rainy Lat 27.46 Long 139.50 E

Thursday March 23rd

Moderate breezes from SSE steady Lat 28.10 Long 140.50 E

Friday March 24th

Light breezes from SE to N L P thick and rainy made Pangs Group heavy & kept off south NW Ch

Saturday March 25th

Light breezes from NNE at sunset shifted to the wind and lay till daylight I find the Group laid down 50 miles to the North on my chart L P kept off for Peel Island Lat 27.35 N Long 142.15.30 East

Sunday March 26th

Moderate breezes and fair weather trying to work up to Port Loyablong Peel Island the ship Meaton of Newcastle in sight Lat 27.05 N

Monday March 27th

At 1 P M I took a Boat and crew and landed at Port Loyablong found the ship Mount Vernon Nye of New Bedford at anchor should L P lay off and on bent the cables and got the anchor of the bow

Tuesday March 28th

Blowing a Moderate gale from NW L P at 11 A M came to anchor in 18 fathoms water

Wednesday March 29th

got off 20 bbls of Potatoes 3 bbls of Apples 1 bbl of Onions and two bbls of the
