Lat By Obs 36.54 N Long 135.15 W

Wednesday April 26th

Cornes in with a strong breeze
from NNE and clear weather
headed NW by wind on P moderate
weather the wind hauled S W steered
NW by N saw seven Junk ends with
fine weather saw the Island of
Niphon the Principle one of the
Japan Islands saw Hinkbacks
Lat By Obs 37.40 N Long 136.33 E

Thursday April 27th

Cornes in with a fresh breeze
from SSW and fair weather
steered NW per compass on P thick
and squally SP foggy steered NW by P
saw a Junk Lat By Obs 38.13 N Long 136.13 E

Friday April 28th

Cornes in with Moderate breeze
from E and fair weather steered
ESE saw a Junk on P have too
SP made sail steered East saw
10 Junks at 10 AM made the
Land bearing East dist 30 miles
saw a high Mountain on
Niphon Apparently covered
with snow Lat By Obs 39.06 N Long 137.11 E

Saturday April 29th

Moderate breeze from SW and fair
weather at 4 PM were off shore
headed W and W by N through the night
SP smoke at 4 AM spoke the Bark
Covington Jewman of Warren 20 months
out 400 lbs Whale oil has been in the
seagoes a month has seen plenty of
Whales but could not strike them
at 9 AM saw Right Whales 3 or 4
but no purpose came up thick
fog broke cloudy Lat 39.32 N Long 138.00 E

Sunday April 30th

Saw a Right Whale lowered without
success saw plenty of Hinkbacks
weather cloudy and hagged the
Covington in sight ends so
Lat By Obs 38.27 N Long 136.23 E

Monday May 1st

Cornes in with fresh breezes from
NNW headed W by S saw Hinkbacks
and Right Whales as wild as hawks
the Covington in company on P
more moderate SP fine weather
chased Whales without success
Lat By Obs 38.08 N Long 136.06.30 E

Tuesday May 2nd

Light airs from E to S and
fine weather chased Whales
without success the C in sight
chasing Whales on P fresh breeze SP
wind increasing lowered for Whales with
out success Lat 38.46 N Long 135.37.30 E

Wednesday May 3rd

Cornes in with a strong breeze from
SSW and heavy weather lowered
for two Right Whales without success
I have had one man sick with
the Disentery the last three weeks
and have tried every remedy I
can think of but without effect
I fear his case is hopeless - Sailed
sails SP saw three sails one Bark sailing
