ends with good weather  
Lat 39.21 N Long 136.52 East

Sunday May 14<sup>th</sup>

Came in with a strong breeze  
from W and clear weather  
steered N saw three whales  
with high spout holes with  
a hump on their backs they  
bore a striking resemblance  
to the Humpback Whale but  
were not on and S. P. wind from  
N to S W steered N E and E N E  
Lat 41.04 N Long 137.46 to 5 E

Monday May 15<sup>th</sup>

Moderate breeze from S W and S  
throughout Steered E saw a  
sail on S at 1 hour and 30 m  
A. M. spoke the ship Rainbow  
Plasket Master nothing this  
sea S. P. saw the Islands  
of Nippon and Aso and two  
small Islands at the mouth of  
the Straits Sangar the Rain sign  
Lat By Obs 41.15 N Long 139.46

Tuesday May 16<sup>th</sup>

Came in with Moderate breeze  
from S and fine weather however  
for two Right Whales but without  
success On and S. P. calm the land  
in sight saw several Dunks  
Lat 41.14 N Long 139.50 E

Wednesday May 17<sup>th</sup>

Came in calm on S took a  
fresh breeze from S. E. which lasted  
till 12 midnight died away calm  
at 3 o'clock took a light breeze  
from S Steered E. S. P. at 8 o'clock  
A. M. entered the Straits of  
Sangar the current setting N. E.  
saw a great number of Dunks  
At 10 passed the city of Matamor  
Lat 41.38 N Long 141.17.15 East

Of New Bedford Bournet towards the Okhotsk  
Thursday May 18<sup>th</sup>

Fresh breeze from W S W and  
cloudy steering E and E by S  
through the Straits saw several  
Dunks on S at 2 A. M. calm  
and Dunks so hoisted a Dunks  
from Teale bound to Matamor  
the people on board if he appeared  
to be friendly and very anxious  
to please Jus Lat 41.09 Long 142.58

Friday May 19<sup>th</sup>

Came in with a fresh breeze  
from S to S. E. headed by wind  
thick fog on S the funnel  
hailed S. P. wind W S W  
and thick Steered E N E  
Lat By Obs 41.40 N Long 143.00 E

Saturday May 20<sup>th</sup>

Strong breeze from W S W all these  
24 hours and cloudy Steered E N E  
On On clear S. P. Steered N E by E  
Lat By Obs 42.02 N Long 148.40 E

Sunday May 21<sup>st</sup>

Came in with Moderate  
breezes from W S W inclining  
to W N at 2 P. M. the wind  
S W on and S. P. light air  
Lat 43.16 N Long 149.30 East

Monday May 22<sup>d</sup>

Came in with a fine breeze from  
S. E. to S and fine weather Steered  
N. E. On S. P. fresh breezes S. P. foggy at  
intervals ends with fine weather  
steering N Lat By Obs 44.46 N Long 151.18

Tuesday May 23<sup>d</sup>

Came in with a fresh breeze from  
S W and fine weather Steered  
N On S. P. strong breezes with thick fog  
took in the light sails and  
hailed the Main sail up at  
3 o'clock A. M. made the Topog. Ids  
two of the Hourie Group bearing
