Island bore N by E dist 35 miles
the tops of the Mountains are all
covered with snow saw Humphreys
Lat by D R 46.58 N Long 151.14 East

Wednesday May 24th

Came in with a light breeze from
SSE and thick fog steered NNE
the ship in Bassett Straits
on P calm and thick fog S P fresh
breezes from NNE and ruggled with
fog and clear at intervals reefed
the topsails Lat 47.20 N Long 150.56.15 E

Thursday May 25th

Strong breezes from NNE and
thick fog headed NW under
short sail on P more moderate
with thick fog and a hard frost
which caused considerable ice and
frost to accumulate on the rigging
and sails S P still continues foggy
the thermometer stood at 32 in air
and 34 in the water the barometer
rising wind hauled to NE and NW
Lat by D R 48.00 N Long by D R 150.05 E

Friday May 26th

Came in with moderate breezes
from ENE and E and thick fog
headed N and N by E on and S P
wind and weather continued the same
Lat by D R 49.10 N Long 150.00 East

Saturday May 27th

Came in with moderate breezes
from E to ESE and thick fog
steered N by E and NNE under
all sail the P cleared up S P fair
weather wind steady at ESE
Lat by D R 50.47 N Long 150.46 East

Sunday May 28th

Came in with a fresh breeze
from ESE and cloudy steered
N and NW West the wind inclining
to N E on P at 9 P M shut in

thick at a cleared off wind N E to
NN E and with fine clear weather
Lat by D R 52.33 N Long 149.36 East

Monday May 29th

Came in with a moderate
breeze from NNE to N and fine
clear weather headed NW and NW
by wind on P calm with light air
at intervals at 3 P M took a breeze from
W steered N S P steered NNE
the water green Lat 53.53 N Long 148.50 E

Tuesday May 30th

Came in with a fresh breeze from
NW and fine weather steered
NN by N on P strong breezes S P
the wind hauled to W saw Finches
Lat 56.22 N Long 146.25 E

Wednesday May 31st

Came in with a fresh
breeze from W and fair
weather saw a sail at 3 P M
saw a large quantity of seals
ice at 4 o'clock spotted the ship
Cooper Fisher of New Bedford
32 on the out 19.00 nothing
this season on P took
several times S P wind
W by S at 10 A M hauled W and
W by N the Cooper in
company Lat 56.53 N Long

Thursday June 1st

Came in with a moderate
breeze from N E to N steered
W and W by S foggy at 1 o'clock
P M cleared off the Cooper
in sight on P took a breeze
from SSW headed W S P saw
a Bow head bounel to windward
lowered without success
Lat 56.44 N Long 144.00 East

Friday June 2nd

Fresh breezes from S to N E and
thick fog steering for Jones Island
