Monday July 31st

Calm and foggy sent three
Boats to the whale to the
ship Anchored with the other
Boats crew at 5 P.M. got the
Whale along side cut in the
throat and Lips and made all
fast for the night on P thick
fog L.P. weather the same wind N.E.
cut in the whale Mr. Woodell off duty
with the end of a finger Landed off

Tuesday Aug 1st

Thick fog the wind N.E. heard
Whales spouting at 6 P.M. cleared
up a little started the day on
on and L.P. thick fog and a heavy
swell

Wednesday Aug 2^d

Comed in thick fog at 2 P.M.
cleared off a little lowered
for whales shut in again
one of the Boats came along
fired guns and blew the horn
for the other Boats at 4 P.M.
cleared up again but saw nothing
of the other Boats at 8 P.M.
the Larboard Boat came along
side with 2 Boats crews having
been fast to a whale and
lost the Main Boat and crew
L.P. three Boats in chase of Bowhead
but without success saw abundance
of whales but very shy

Thursday Aug 3^d

Comed in with a light breeze
from N.E. and fair weather
employed in boiling and chas-
ing whales put out on three
Boats on and L.P. thick fog at 4 P.M.
A.M. got under way and up the Bay
at 11 came to again cooled down
getting ready to stow down

Friday Aug 4th

Comed in with a fresh breeze from
N.E. at 3 P.M. cleared up three ships
in sight at Anchor and one under
way employed in stowing down
L.P. thick fog

Saturday Aug 5th

Calm two boats off cruising
the others employed in stowing down
counted 35 ships in sight at P
two Boats off finished stowing down
Capt. Dexter of the Meteor came
on board

Sunday Aug 6th

Calm saw a few whales very shy
at sunset the Boats came on board
L.P. the Boats off cruising struck
and killed a whale

Monday Aug 7th

Comed in the whale till 1 o'clock
night before the other boats found
one L.P. took the whale along
side

Tuesday Aug 8th

Went in the whale with two
boats crews the others chasing

Wednesday Aug 9th

Two Boats crews off cruising the
others employed in boiling

Thursday Aug 10th

Employed in boiling three boats
off cruising

Friday Aug 11th

Employed in boiling and sitting
up clock L.P. cooled down

Saturday Aug 12th

Three boats off the wind N.E.
being from S.E. to S.W. the boats
were
