

Tuesday Aug 29th

Employed in boiling three boats
off cruising

Wednesday Aug 30th

Employed in boiling, weather
foggy took the Anchor in company
with the John Coggeshall and
Barks Gentleman and Edward

Thursday Aug 31st

Thick fog with intervals of clear
weather at 2 P.M. came too again

Friday Sept 1st

Calm with fog and clear at
intervals stowed off the
Fore Hatch two Boats off
Bought two coils of towline of
the Barks Gentleman

Saturday Sept 2^d

Calm and foggy employed
in stowing the after Hatch
and setting a new pot one
of the others being broken

Sunday Sept 3^d

Light breeze from N finished
stowing and took the anchor
and stowed in shore sent four
casks ashore for water at 6 came
to again in 18 fathoms of water.
At 1 P.M. got underway again
and stowed off and out the boat
returned with the water, however
two Boats for a Bowhead but
did not see him again

Monday Sept 4th

Calm the ship drifting with
the tide at 7 o'clock P.M. came
to Anchor in 20 fathoms of
water 37 ships in sight, boiling

Tuesday Sept 5th

Fresh breeze from S beating
into Diamond Bay saw perhaps
6 Whales going quick to windward
no ships in sight two cutting
at 4 P.M. came to Anchor close
to the Harmony N.S. no Whales
in sight at 10 sent two Boats
off saw nothing

Wednesday Sept 6th

Calm at 10 got under way with
a fresh breeze employed in
scrapping bone saw no Whales

Thursday Sept 7th

Strong breeze from N and regg
came to Anchor thick fog
at 5 P.M. strong breeze took
the Anchor hake the stock
stowed in shore and Anchored
again and sent a Boat in
the cut timber to make an
other with 5 other ships at
Anchor here

Friday Sept 8th

Strong breeze from N.W. with
a heavy swell on S the
wind increasing at 10 blowing
strong and very regg got
under way and ran into
Potter Bay under a good lee
in smooth water in 7 fathoms
of water found the Joseph
Hayden of Bremen at Anchor
the India N.B. and Montreal and
several other ships came in
for shelter finished the Anchor
stock and put the Anchor on
the Bow

Saturday Sept 9th

Two Boats crew off looking
for Whales one boat working
and one Boat crew sick at
the Montreal and conveyed
went out
