

Wednesday Oct 4th 1854

Comes in more moderate with passing squalls steered S.E. made sail on 50 strong from N.W. ends the same made all sail Lat 51.00 Long 49.50 E

Thursday Oct 5th

Comes in with strong breezes from N.W. and fair weather steered S by E under all sail on P light air ends the same Lat 49.18 N Long 149.40 W 15.06

Friday Oct 6th

Light breezes from N to N.W. all these 24 hours steered S by E Lat Obs 47.48 N Long 148.27 E

Saturday Oct 7th

Variable breezes all these 24 hours with thick cloudy weather No Obs

Sunday Oct 8th

Comes in with strong breezes from N.W. and thick weather at 4 PM wind increasing put the ship under double reefed topsails and fore sail and wore ship headed N wind E.N.E. On P blowing a strong gale took in the fore topsail at 9 wore ship and headed E by N wind N at 11 A.M. kept off S.E. by E for Bassville Straits at 12 noon made Broughton Island in the Straits bearing South Lat 47.10 N Long 152.15 W

Monday Oct 9th

Comes in with a strong gale from N and cloudy steered S.E. by S at sunset Broughton Island bore W by N dist 18 miles Forbay Island S.W. by S Merican Island E by N ends with strong breezes steering S by E Lat 44.58 N Long 152.52 E

Tuesday Oct 10th 1854

Strong gales throughout with squally weather took in sail
