

1863 Ship Mary of Edgartown

Tuesday April 14th

A.M. Fresh breezes from East and fine weather. Steered N.N.E. by wind saw Blackfish and Porpoises. Two men sick. Lat 6.10 N Long 110.25 East. P.M. fresh breezes head S.E. rain squalls.

Wednesday April 15th

A.M. Fresh breezes from E and squally with heavy showers of rain at 10 o'clock. Lat 5.40 N Long 110.36 E. P.M. calm nothing seen.

Thursday April 16th

A.M. a fresh breeze from E.N.E. and fair weather. Steered S.E. all sail. Lat 7.02 N Long 110.41 E. P.M. squally with rain. Ripley repairing casks saw Porpoises and small fish.

Friday April 17th

A.M. Fresh breezes from N. and E and squally. Steered S.E. and N employed repairing casks nothing seen on the ground. Lat 6.57 N Long 110.54 E. P.M. heavy squalls of rain with thunder and lightning. find the current setting strong.

Saturday April 18th

A.M. Strong breezes from N.E. and fair weather. Steered S.E. and S.E. by wind. Lat 6.03 N Long 111.21 E. P.M. strong breezes nothing seen. repairing casks.

Sunday April 19th

A.M. strong breezes from N.E. Steered N.E. nothing seen. Lat 6.22 N Long 111.16 E. P.M. weather the same.

Monday April 20th

Fresh breezes and fair weather. a strong current setting N.W. nothing seen. Lat 7.13 N Long 111.04 E.

Tuesday April 21st

A fresh breeze and fine weather throughout. nothing seen but porpoises. Lat 10.40 N Long 111.54 E.

Wednesday April 22^d

A.M. Fresh breezes from N.E. and fine weather. Steered S.E. nothing seen on the ground. Lat 6.12 N Long 112.25 E. P.M. Steered North saw drift.

Thursday April 23^d

A.M. light variable breezes with fine rain. Lat 6.35 N Long 112.35 E. P.M. heavy showers of rain.

Friday April 24th

Throughout variable breezes and thick rainy weather. Lat 6.45 N Long 113.54 E. nothing seen on the ground.
