

1863 Ship Mary of Edgartown Thos Monitor

Monday May 4th

Light breeze from S. throughout
and fine weather. Saw
a sail standing to the N.
Cape Barrella bore S.W. a
strong current setting S.W.
Lat Obs 13.15 N Long 110.11 E
P.M. calm saw nothing of the
spouting kind.

Tuesday May 5th

Light breeze from S.E. and E
and fine weather. Steered
to the Northward the coast of
Cochin China in sight
lowered for Blackfish took two
Lat Obs 13.58 N Long 110.08 E
P.M. showers of rain steered
N. and S.W. saw a sail hoisting
Blackfish Blubber.

Wednesday May 6th

A light breeze throughout
and fine weather. The land
in sight no whales seen
Lat Obs 13.28 N Long 110.20 E
P.M. a shower of rain

Thursday May 7th

A light breeze and
fine weather. Heaved off
and over shore. The water
and from below the water
looks about right for Spence
Lat Obs 13.10 N Long 110.20 E
Coopering oil

Friday May 8th

Light air and fine
weather. Stowed down the
oil the land in sight saw fish
Lat Obs 13.35 N Long 110.16 E
P.M. steered N.S.W.

1863 Cruising Off Coast Cochin China

Saturday May 9th

A.M. light air from
S.W. steered to Cape
Barrella bore N.W. 8 miles
saw 16 up flacks
a sail in sight
Lat Obs 13.55 N Long 110.20 E
P.M. calm at 11 o'clock
took a breeze from East

Sunday May 10th

Light air from S.E. and E
and fine weather. The land
in sight saw a Bark
Lat 12.20 N Long 110.10 E

Monday May 11th

Light variable air and
fine weather. Cape Barrella
bore N.W. saw Blackfish
a Bark in sight. Sound
Lat 12.30 N Long 110.11 E
P.M. at 5 saw Spouts 5 miles

Tuesday May 12th

All M. Heavy showers of
rain at 7 o'clock cleared up
the Cape Barrella bore N.W.
Lat Obs 13.58 N Long 110.14 E
P.M. light air nothing seen

Wednesday May 13th

A.M. Fresh breeze from
N.S.W. to S.E. and fine weather
steered by wind on opposite
tacks nothing seen but land
Lat Obs 13.38 N Long 110.25 E
P.M. strong breeze saw
Porpoises and small fish
