Friday
Oct 23rd

A.M. Gloomy weather with
rain employed in boiling
on the 21st took a 40 lb
Bull and cut him in
on the 23rd saw them
again lowered the boats
but lost the run of them
in the squalls saw the
Atlantic and an English
ship formerly the Light of
Boston 6 days from Singapore
Lat 5.50 N Long 111.16 East

Saturday Nov 14th

Light breeze from N.W. to E
and fair weather steered
South all these 24 hours
since last date have had
a great deal of bad weather
have run as far to the East
as the shoal supplied the
Atlantic with 2 casks of
Bread & 7 Bbls of Pork
have had a strong steady current
setting to the N about 3 knots
find it hard to keep on the
ground on the 9th saw a Sp
Whale going quick to N.W.
lowered but saw no more
of him on the 11th saw
a school of Sp Whales lowered
and struck & killed a cow &
Bull the A. got nothing had
a heavy swell hard cutting
Lat to day 6.25 N Long 111.12 East

The Atlantic put on board Singapore
on the 13th
