

1865 Ship Mary of Edgartown

January 22^d



Since last date came through the Palau Straits across the Mindoro sea through Bassalar Straits to Perugani Islands. from there to Salibabgo for water from there to Morby where we cruised till the 2^d of Dec saw 10 Whales twice got nothing from there to Morby Passage to Kuma and Perugani spoke the Barke Buewster 27 months past 830 lbs passed Greyhound Straits the Boatman saw nothing there from there to Bours & Ceram. Bours saw nothing from there to Goram & Cape Kator on the 16th off Pulo Addie at 8 o'clock a m saw a school of sperm whales low creck and took 6 whales one of them a large one yesterday stored down 1030

Feb 9th Fine weather the Mattabula Islands "Goram" Manoro and New Guinea in sight the Barke Brewster capt Buew also in sight on the first took four sperm whales Goram bearing West 80 miles on the 3^d the Brewster took one since then have seen nothing

Sho Morrison Master Whaling 1865-

Thursday April 27th

Since last date cruised off Goram till the 27th of Feb took a Whal on the 17th on the 27th got ten barrels of Bup and 30. lbs of sperm oil from the Barke Brewster 25th put away and beat up the North shore of Ceram on the 7th of March anchored in Belali Bay. Bours the Ship Gayelle capt J. H. North came in on the 10th on the 14th got under weigh in company with the G. crocker the Bandag sea and passed through Timor Straits 24th anchored in Lapan Timor 28th sailed and passed Savu and Sandalwood on the 17th experienced a heavy blow it had been threatening for several days with dark heavy clouds and squall very low the Bar fell the night before and continued to fall till the height of the gale it stood at 29.70. since then have had fair weather we were in lat 22.55 South long 71.00 23.5th saw a school of sperm whales going quick to N. E. lowered and got one 30 blb whale and set him in lat 24.10 South long 49.00 East lat to day 25.15 S. long 48.48 East storing N. N. W. at 2.30 P m cooled down
