Remarks on board Cape Horn Barge
Saturday Sep 11th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and pleasant weather from NE, got ready for cutting and commenced to cut, at sundown shortened sail, Middle part fresh breeze, Latter part moderate breeze and clear at daylight commenced to cut again.

Sunday Sep 12th

First part commenced with a calm, finished cutting and baled the bale, Middle part calm, Latter part calm, employed in boiling.

Monday Sep 13th

First part commenced with a calm, employed in boiling, put letters on board of the Brig James Miller, Middle part calm, Latter part light breeze from SE, employed in boiling, several sails in sight, put letters on board of the Glory of the Sea bound to Cork.

Tuesday Sep 14th

First part commenced with light air from SE heading SE, employed in boiling, the Capt of the Brig James Miller came on board a little while to see us boil, Middle part light breeze, Latter part moderate breeze and clear.

Wednesday Sep 15th

First part commenced with light breeze and pleasant weather from E heading SE, employed in boiling, finished boiling at 10 P.M., Middle part light breeze, Latter part light breeze and clear.

Thursday Sep 16th

First part commenced with light breeze and pleasant weather from E heading SE by S, Middle part light breeze, Latter part moderate breeze and clear.

Friday Sep 17th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and pleasant weather from E heading SE, employed in breaking out water and getting ready to stow down Oil, Middle part moderate breeze, Latter part moderate breeze and clear, employed in stowing down Oil.

Saturday Sep 18th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and pleasant weather from E heading SE, employed in stowing down Oil, Middle part moderate breeze, Latter part moderate breeze and clear.

Sunday Sep 19th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and pleasant weather from E heading SE, at 4 P.M. finished stowing down Oil, Middle part fresh breeze, Latter part fresh breeze and clear from SE heading SE, Lat 22. 52 N

Monday Sep 20th

First part commenced with fresh breeze and pleasant weather from SE heading SE, at 1 P.M. tacked Ship, Middle part fresh breeze, Latter part moderate breeze and happy, employed in breaking out shoals.
