Bermarks on board Cape Horn Pigeon
Monday Oct 11th

First part commences with fresh breeze from WSW starting S. at 4 P.M. raised Spinn Whales on the lee beam going quick to the windward, toward 3 Boats and the Starboard Boat struck one, took him alongside at dark, Middle part strong breeze, latter part strong breeze and rainy.

Tuesday Oct 12th

First part commences with fresh breeze and cloudy weather from W. cut in the Whale and put him in the tank Middle part strong breeze, latter part strong breeze from SSW heading SE.

Wednesday Oct 13th

First part commences with strong breeze and clear weather from SSW heading SE. Middle part fresh breeze, latter part fresh breeze and clear, at 6 A.M. started the works.

Thursday Oct 14th

First part commences with fresh breeze (starboard) and clear weather from SSE heading SW at 4 P.M. finished boiling. Middle part light winds, latter part fresh breeze and clear.

Friday Oct 15th

First part commences with light winds from S. saw Haddock. Middle part fresh breeze, latter part strong breeze and squally from S.

Outward Bound

Saturday Oct 16th

First part commences with strong breeze and cloudy weather from SSW heading SE. Middle part strong breeze, latter part strong breeze and clear heading SE.

Sunday Oct 17th

First part commences with strong breeze and cloudy weather from SSW heading SE. Middle part strong breeze, latter part the same Sat 5. of 1.

Monday Oct 18th

First part commences with strong breeze from SSW heading SE, at 3 P.M. tacked Ship. Middle part fresh breeze, latter part light breeze and clear, at 8 A.M. raised Spinn Whales, lowered all the boat and after chasing some time the low boat struck one.

Tuesday Oct 19th

First part commences with moderate breeze and clear weather from SSW at 4 P.M. took the Whale alongside, got the tackle up and cut him in. Middle part light breeze, latter part light breeze and clear, at 6 A.M. started the works.

Wednesday Oct 20th

First part commences with fresh breeze and pleasant weather from SSW heading W. employed in boiling. Middle part light breeze, finished boiling, latter part moderate breeze and clear.
