Remarks on board Cape Horn Pigeon
Sunday Dec 26th

First part commenced with fresh breeze from NW heading WSW. Middle part light breeze latter part fresh breeze and squally at 1 PM tacked ship to the NNE. Lat 37.10 S

Monday Dec 27th

First part commenced with fresh breeze and squally weather from W heading NNE 1 sail in sight. Middle part light winds. Latter part moderate breeze and clear from N steering NNE Lat 36.23 S

Tuesday Dec 28th

First part commenced with fresh breeze from NNE steering WNW. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part moderate breeze and foggy from E steering WNW.

Wednesday Dec 29th

First part commenced with fresh breeze and clear weather from S steering NW. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part fresh breeze and cloudy from W heading NNE Lat 33.18 S

Thursday Dec 30th

First part commenced with fresh breeze and cloudy weather from W. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part fresh breeze steering NW Lat 30.59 S

Friday Dec 31st

First part commenced with strong breeze and clear weather from SW steering NNE. Middle part strong breeze. Latter part more moderate made some sail Lat 48.30 S

Saturday Jan 1st

1881

First part commenced with strong breeze and squally weather from SW steering NW. Middle part squally. Latter part strong breeze and squally at 12 M luffed by the wind under short sail heading NNE Lat 46.00 S

Sunday Jan 2nd

First part commenced with strong breeze and squally weather from SW. Middle part strong breeze. Latter part fresh breeze and cloudy made some sail

Monday Jan 3rd

First part commenced with fresh breeze and cloudy weather from NW heading NNE at sundown took in sail and wore ship. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part fresh breeze and raining from NNE

Tuesday Jan 4th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and foggy weather from NW. Middle part the same. Latter part fresh breeze and clear steering E
