Wednesday Jan 5th

First part commences with strong breeze
and clear weather from WSW heading SSW.
Middle part blowing a gale. Latter part
blowing strong steering NWN Lat 44.48 S

Thursday Jan 6th

First part commences with strong breeze
and clear weather from W heading NWN.
Middle part blowing strong. Latter part
the same Lat 45.19 S

Friday Jan 7th

First part commences with strong breeze
from W heading NWN. Middle part blowing
strong. Latter part strong breeze and squally
from SW steering NWN under close reefed
topsails and reefed courses Lat 46.40 S

Saturday Jan 8th

First part commences with strong breeze
and squally weather from SW steering
NWN. Middle part blowing strong. Latter
part strong breeze steering the same
Lat 48.53 S

Sunday Jan 9th

First part commences with strong breeze
and squally weather from WSW steering
NWN. Middle part strong breeze. Latter
part fresh breeze and clear Lat 56.55 S

Monday Jan 10th

First part commences with fresh breeze
and clear weather from SSW steering
NWN. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter
part fresh breeze at daylight saw the Island
of Massafuera

Tuesday Jan 11th

First part commences with fresh breeze
and pleasant weather from S cruising.
at sundown took in sail. Middle part
light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze and
cloudy from SNE at daylight made sail.

Wednesday Jan 12th

First part commences with moderate breeze
and clear weather from S at sundown took in
sail. Middle part light breeze. Latter part
light breeze and clear employed in repairing the
Main Sail.

Thursday Jan 13th

First part commences with light breeze and
pleasant weather from S. finished the main sail
and bent it, at sundown took in sail. Middle
part light breeze. Latter part light breeze
and clear from NNE employed in various jobs

Friday Jan 14th

First part commences with light breeze and
pleasant weather from NNE at sundown took
in sail. Middle part light breeze. Latter part
light breeze from NNE at daylight made sail
employed in mending the sails

Saturday Jan 15th

First part commences with light breeze and
partly clear weather from NE. Coaled the
anchors, at sundown took in sail. Middle part
light breeze. Latter part fresh breeze and clear
repaired the fore sail
