First part commences with fresh breeze and rainy weather steering S.E. at 7 P.M. passed Massajura. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part light breeze from S.E.

Saturday Mar 19th

First part commences with light airs from S steering S.E. Juan in sight bearing E. Middle part light airs. Latter part moderate breeze from N.W. steering for Juan.
