Remarks on board Cape Horn Pigeon
Sunday Mar 20th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and pleasant weather from W at 1 P.M. Capt Kelley went ashore at Juan ~~and~~ returned again at 5th P.M. took in sail. Middle part fresh breeze latter part fresh breeze and clear

Monday Mar 21st

First part commenced with fresh breeze and clear weather from WNW saw several finbacks. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part fresh breeze and clear sent a raft of casks ashore after water.

Tuesday Mar 22nd

First part commenced with fresh breeze and pleasant weather got off the raft of water and stored it below. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part moderate breeze and clear at 8 P.M. Capt Kelley went ashore.

Wednesday Mar 23rd

First part commenced with light breeze and pleasant weather, at 2 P.M. towed off a lighter load of wood and some potatoes. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part light breeze and clear, sent 2 boats ashore after potatoes and 1 boat fishing.

Thursday Mar 24th

First part commenced with light breeze and pleasant weather, at 1 P.M. got the potatoes off and stored to the W. Middle part light breeze. Latter part light breeze and clear, employed in sawing and splitting some of the large sticks of wood to put below

Cruising for Sperm Whales
Friday Mar 25th

First part commenced with light breeze and pleasant weather from SE heading N.W. employed in sawing and splitting wood. Middle part light air. Latter part light breeze from SE and E, steering W.S.W.

Saturday Mar 26th

First part commenced with light breeze and clear at 3 P.M. raised Sperm Whales 4 miles off ahead of the ship. Lowered 3 boats and gave chase but did not get very near them came on board at dark. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part strong breeze and clear

Sunday Mar 27th

First part commenced with strong breeze and clear weather from SE heading S.W. Massajuna bearing S distant 30 miles. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part moderate breeze and clear made sail.

Monday Mar 28th

First part commenced with fresh breeze and pleasant weather from SE at sundown wore ship and took in sail. Middle part strong breeze. Latter part strong breeze from E.S.E.

Tuesday Mar 29th

First part commenced with strong breeze and cloudy weather from E steering N. Middle part strong breeze. Latter part strong breeze from SE made all sail
