breeze from SE. Tacked ship and headed SSW

Monday May 9th

First part commences with fresh breeze
and clear weather from SE. Middle
part light breeze. Latter part light breeze
and clear. Wenman's in sight.

Tuesday May 10th

First part commences with light breeze
and pleasant weather 2 sails in sight.
Middle part light breeze. Latter part
light breeze and clear.

Wednesday May 11th

First part commences with light airs
and pleasant weather jammed with
the Jane Martin. Middle part calm.
Latter part fresh breeze. North head in sight.

Thursday May 12th

First part commences with a calm.
Middle part calm. Latter part light airs.

Friday May 13th

First part commences with light breeze
from S. Middle part calm. Latter
part calm.

First part commences with a calm. Middle
part fresh breeze. Latter part calm. at
7 AM raised Sperm Whales going quick
lowered the boats and chased them, a breeze
sprung up and the Waist Boat struck one.

took the Whale alongside and cut him in.
Middle part light breeze. Latter part light
breeze at daylight started the works.

Monday May 16th

First part commences with light breeze
from ESE boiling. Middle part calm.
at 4 AM finished boiling. Latter part
about calm.

Tuesday May 17th

First part commences with a calm. Middle
part light breeze. Latter part fresh breeze
employed in stowing down oil.

Wednesday May 18th

First part commences with a calm. Middle
part calm. Latter part calm. repaired the
Main Top Gallant sail.

Thursday May 19th

First part commences with a calm. Middle
part calm. Latter part light airs.
