

Remarks on board Cape Horn Pigion

Friday July 1st

First part commenced with light breeze and cloudy weather saw no Whales today. Middle part light breeze and rainy. Latter part light breeze at daylight made sail and lowered 2 boats

Saturday July 2nd

First part commenced with light breeze at dark anchored at the head of the bay. Middle part calm. Latter part fresh breeze and squally, at daylight hove up anchor and made sail. at 10 A.M. anchored at Hoga

Sunday July 3rd

First part commenced with a calm. Middle part calm. Latter part light airs and calms hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats

Monday July 4th

First part commenced with light breeze and pleasant weather anchored at 5 o'clock. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part moderate breeze hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats, stood for Santa Bay

Tuesday July 5th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and squally weather anchored at night. Middle part light breeze. Latter part light breeze and rainy hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats

In Panama Bay

Wednesday July 6th

First part commenced with a calm, at night anchored. Middle part fresh in sight. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats

Thursday July 7th

First part commenced with light breeze at dark anchored. Middle part light breeze. Latter part light breeze hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats

Friday July 8th

First part commenced with moderate breeze steering for the Pearl Islands at dark anchored. Middle part light breeze. Latter part rainy.

Saturday July 9th

First part commenced with fresh breeze from S.W. breaking out provisioning the Sea Fox anchored outside. at 3 P.M. hove up anchor and steered N.E. at dark anchored. Middle part light breeze. Latter part light breeze hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats

Sunday July 10th

First part commenced with moderate breeze steering for the Pearl Islands at 8 P.M. anchored in 33 fathoms of water. Middle part calm. Latter part rainy at 9 hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats
