Remarks on board Cape Horn Vign

Monday July 11th

First part commences with light air from different directions the Starboard boat struck a Whale and got capsized, lost the Whale. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze lowered 3 boats

Tuesday July 12th

First part commences with moderate breeze and clear weather the Waist Boat struck a Cow and calf, killed him and towed him to the Ship. Middle part light breeze Latter part light breeze, cut the Whale in and hove up anchor,

Wednesday July 13th

First part commences with moderate breeze and clear weather lowered 2 boats and started the works anchored at night. Middle part light breeze Latter part fresh breeze lowered 3 boats

Thursday July 14th

First part commences with moderate breeze boats came aboard at night. Middle part finished boiling Latter part rainy at 10 AM lowered 3 boats

Friday July 15th

First part commences with moderate breeze, at night the boats came aboard. Middle part light breeze Latter part light breeze lowered 3 boats. Stowed down oil

In Panama Bay

Saturday July 16th

First part commences with light breeze at night the boats came on board. Middle part light breeze Latter part moderate breeze lowered 3 boats

Sunday July 17th

First part commences with moderate breeze the Waist boat struck a Whale and he run quite bad, killed him at sundown some distance from the Ship, towed the Whale part of the night and the other part anchored. Middle part calm. Latter part light winds with some rain, hove up the anchor and went to the Whale, anchored and cut the Whale in.

Monday July 18th

First part commences with a calm started the works. Middle part light breeze. Latter part rainy finished boiling.

Tuesday July 19th

First part commences with light breeze hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats anchored again and got 2 casks of water from shore. Middle part calm Latter part light breeze lowered 3 boats, got 5 casks of water from shore, the Starboard boat struck a Whale, killed him and shot another one. the Waist boat struck him

Wednesday July 20th

First part commences with light breeze got the Whales along side and anchored. Middle part calm Latter part calm cut the Whales in
