Friday Oct 7th

These 24 hours breezes discharged some oil and set up some shocks

Saturday Oct 8th

These 24 hours changeable weather employed in setting up shocks

Sunday Oct 9th

These 24 hours fresh breezes and clear weather

Monday Oct 10th

These 24 hours strong breezes and clear weather. got the oil all out and took provisions and shocks from the lighter

Tuesday Oct 11th

These 24 hours light breezes and pleasant weather employed in setting up shocks and stowing the ground and filling with salt water

Wednesday Oct 12th

These 24 hours fresh breezes and pleasant weather broke out the after hole and stowed casks for salt water. setting up shocks

Thursday Oct 13th

These 24 hours moderate breezes and pleasant weather employed in setting up shocks and stowing the after hole

Friday Oct 14th

These 24 hours light breezes and pleasant weather employed in stowing the hole and setting up shocks etc

Saturday Oct 15th

These 24 hours fresh breezes and cloudy weather Port watch ashore on liberty

Sunday Oct 16th

These 24 hours fresh breezes and cloudy weather Starboard watch ashore on liberty

Monday Oct 17th

These 24 hours fresh breezes and clear weather Port watch ashore on liberty

Tuesday Oct 18th

These 24 hours light winds and pleasant weather Starboard watch ashore on liberty

Wednesday Oct 19th

These 24 hours light winds and pleasant weather employed in setting up shocks etc

Thursday Oct 20th

These 24 hours light breezes and pleasant weather at 9 A.M. got under way and started for the Pearl Islands. at 4 P.M. about calm anchored again. at 8 P.M. hove up anchor again. and at 8 1/2 P.M. anchored.
