Remarks on board Cape Horn Pigeon

Friday Oct 27th
These 24 hours light winds and pleasant weather, setting up shooks

Saturday Oct 28th
These 24 hours light and fresh winds from different directions at dark anchored.

Sunday Oct 29th
These 24 hours fresh breezes with some rain at 11 1/2 AM hove up anchor and made sail a strong head current running, at dark anchored again. saw the Schooner Calab Coton at anchor off Chapera

Monday Oct 30th
These 24 hours light winds hove up the anchor and anchored again close to Chapera, got a raft of water. Calab Coton at anchor close to us

Tuesday Oct 31st
These 24 hours calms and light breezes lowered for a Cow and calf and the Waist Boat struck, killed him and got him alongside at 8 P.M.

Wednesday Oct 26th
These 24 hours calms and light breezes cut the Whale in and cut the blubber. at 8 P.M. started the works

Thursday Oct 27th
These 24 hours light breezes and calms, boiling, at 2 P.M. hove up anchor and made sail, at 4 P.M. anchored again toward 2 boats

Friday Oct 28th

These 24 hours light winds and calms at daylight finished boiling hove up anchor and made sail toward 2 boats. at 12 M anchored off Chapera and got a raft of water

Saturday Oct 29th

These 24 hours fresh breezes with some rain employed in cutting wood and setting up shooks

Sunday Oct 30th

These 24 hours fresh breezes with some rain

Monday Oct 31st

These 24 hours fresh breezes, stowed down the oil and got a raft of water and cut some wood and brought a boat load on board

Tuesday Nov 1st

These 24 hours fresh breeze with some rain. got off some wood and run some water below and coal tarred the bonds

Wednesday Nov 2nd

These 24 hours fresh breeze, got off 2 rafts of water and some wood

Thursday Nov 3rd

These 24 hours moderate breeze and some rain got off 4 boat loads of wood and put it below and run some water below. Calab Coton sailed.
