Remarks on Board Cape Horn Pigeon
Thursday Nov 17th

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First part commenced with strong breeze from NW heading N.E. in setting the Main & 1st gallant sail the foot rope parted and tore the sail, sent the sail down and repaired it and sent it again. Middle part strong breeze reefed the 1st sail. Latter part blowing strong heading NW

Friday Nov 18th

First part commences with fresh breeze
made more sail, at 4 PM reefed the
top sails. Middle part strong breeze. Latter
part more moderate made some sail.

Saturday Nov 17th

First part commences with moderate
breeze heading S by E. Middle part moderate
later part moderate, the Island of Sagoa
in sight on the horizon

Sunday Nov 20th

First part commences with moderate breeze from W. S.W. the Capt. Mate, Second Mate, Fourth Mate, one Boatswain, and Mrs Kelly all sick with the fever. Middle part moderate breeze at 12 tacked Ship. Latter part moderate

Monday Nov 21st

First part commences with moderate
haze working up the coast at 9 A.M.
tagged ship off shore. Middle part fresh
haze. Latter part fresh.

Tuesday Nov 22nd

First part fresh breeze the sight about the same. Middle part strong breeze latter part strong breeze

Wednesday Nov 23rd

First part strong breeze, ~~the~~ some more
come down sick with the fever. Middle
part fresh breeze, at 10 o'clock the Boatsteward
died. Latter part fresh breeze, buried the
dead

Thursday. Nov 24th

First part commences with fresh breeze
the sick about the same, all hands sick
aft but 2 Boatstealers. Middle part. fresh
breeze. Latter part fresh breeze, working
up the coast

Friday Nov 28th

First part fresh breeze, some of the pick
gaining a little. Middle part fresh breeze.
 Latter part light breeze

Saturday Nov 26th

First part commences with fresh breeze,
passed Comeraldas, Middle, part strong
breeze latter part fresh breeze Anchored
at Otacama Cal. Later at anchor
