First part commenced with fresh breeze and clear weather. Middle part strong breeze. Latter part light breeze.

Monday Dec 26th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and clear weather steering for Sumner. at sundown anchored a little to the leeward of Sumner. Middle part light breeze. Latter part light breeze. hove up the anchor and went in shore a little farther and anchored again. employed in various jobs

Tuesday Dec 27th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and clear weather, the Capt went ashore, employed in painting iron work and blocks. Middle part light breeze. Latter part light breeze and clear

Wednesday Dec 28th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and pleasant weather employed in painting iron work and blocks. Painted the main Mast. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze

Thursday Dec 29th

First part commenced with moderate breeze, one man sick forward, employed in various jobs. Middle part light breeze. Latter part light breeze

Friday Dec 30th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and pleasant weather. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze.

First part commenced with moderate breeze and pleasant weather. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze. 2 canoe loads of sweet potatoes came along side shipped 1 man
