Remarks on Board Cape Horn Pigeon

Friday Feb 3rd
First part commenced with fresh breeze and pleasant weather the boats came on board. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part fresh breeze

Saturday Feb 4th
First part commenced with moderate breeze and clear weather steering different courses. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part light breeze repaired the spunk

Sunday Feb 5th
First part commenced with light breeze and pleasant weather. Middle part light breeze. Latter part light breeze and clear.

Monday Feb 6th
First part commenced with light breeze and pleasant weather steering N by N. Middle part light breeze. Latter part light breeze and clear

Tuesday Feb 7th
First part commenced with light breeze and pleasant weather steering N by N. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze

Wednesday Feb 8th
First part commenced with moderate breeze and pleasant weather. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze and cloudy steering N by N

Thursday Feb 9th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and cloudy weather from S steering N by N. Middle part light breeze. Latter part light breeze and squally

Friday Feb 10th
First part commenced with light breeze steering N by N. Middle part light breeze luffed by the wind with the foreyard aback. Latter part light breeze.

Saturday Feb 11th
First part commenced with light breeze and cloudy weather steering N by N. Middle part light breeze. Main yard aback. Latter part light breeze washed ship inside

Sunday Feb 12th
First part commenced with light breeze from E steering N. Middle part light breeze. Latter part light breeze and clear

Monday Feb 13th
First part commenced with moderate breeze and pleasant at 12^o raised Spinn-Whales. Lowered 3 boats and the Starboard boat struck. Killed the Whale and took him alongside and the other boats chased on after more. They came aboard after dark. Middle part light breeze. Latter part light breeze and clear at daylight commenced to cut
