Remarks on board Cape Horn Tugboat

Tuesday Feb 17th

First part commences with light breeze and pleasant weather, finished cutting the whale and bailed the case. Middle part light breeze started the works. Latter part light breeze.

Wednesday Feb 18th

First part commences with light breeze and pleasant weather, employed in coiling and cutting up rubber. Middle part light breeze. Latter part light breeze coiling.

Thursday Feb 19th

First part commences with light breeze and pleasant weather from ESE heading. Employed in coiling. Middle part light breeze finished coiling. Latter part light breeze, one of the pots is cracked.

Friday Feb 20th

First part commences with light breeze and pleasant weather. Middle part light breeze. Latter part about calm. Stowing down oil.

Saturday Feb 21st

First part commences with a calm, finished stowing down oil. Middle part calm. Latter part calm.

Sunday Feb 22nd

First part commences with moderate breeze and squally weather, steering N. Middle part calm. Latter part light breeze.

First part commences with moderate breeze and hazy weather. Middle part calm. Latter part light breeze. Took out the cracked pot and put the deck pot in its place.

Tuesday Feb 21st

First part commences with a calm, employed in setting the pot. Middle part calm. Latter part light breeze heading N by W.

Wednesday Feb 22nd

First part commences with light breeze and pleasant weather heading N. Middle part light breeze. Latter part light breeze and clear heading NNE nothing in sight.

Thursday Feb 23rd

First part commences with moderate breeze and pleasant weather from E heading NNE. Middle part light breeze. Latter part light breeze and clear.

Friday Feb 24th

First part commences with a calm. Albemarle in sight. Middle part calm. Latter part calm, employed in various jobs.

Saturday Feb 25th

First part commences with light breeze and pleasant weather. Middle part calm. Latter part calm.
