Remarks on board Cape Horn Steamer

Sunday Feb 26th

First part commences with light breeze and pleasant weather. Middle part calm. Latter part calm.

Monday Feb 27th

First part commences with moderate breeze from S.E. heading N.E. Cullikins in sight. Middle part light breeze. Latter part light air.

Tuesday Feb 28th

First part commences with light air from S.E. heading E. Middle part calm. Latter part light air.

Wednesday Mar 1st

First part commenced with light breeze and pleasant weather. Middle part light breeze. Latter part light breeze heading

Thursday Mar 2nd

First part commenced with light breeze and pleasant weather heading E by N. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze at 6 A.M. raised sperm whaling, lugged the boats and got 5. Starboard boat got 1, Starboard boat got 2. Waist boat got 1. took the Whales alongside and got dinner. the Bow Boat got rolled over and lost his Whale and line and picked up a dead Whale.

Friday Mar 3rd

First part commences with light breeze and pleasant weather, got ready for drifting and cut in 2 Whales. Middle part light breeze. Latter part light breeze and clear cut in the other Whales.

Saturday Mar 4th

First part commences with light breeze from S.W. heading S.E. employed in clearing away heads and cutting up blubber, started the byworks. Middle part rainy. Latter part rain squalls.

Sunday Mar 5th

First part commences with light air and some rain, boiling. Middle part calm. Latter part about calm, boiling.

Monday Mar 6th

First part commences with light air, finished boiling. Middle part fresh breeze and raining. Latter part light breeze steering S.E.

Tuesday Mar 7th

First part commenced with light breeze and pleasant weather steering S.E. by S. Middle part rainy. Latter part moderate breeze, getting ready to start on oil.
