Remarks on board Cape Horn Pigeon
Wednesday June 21st

First part moderate breeze and clear weather lowered 2 boats. the Bow Boat struck a Humpback. killed him and took him alongside and cut him in. at dark anchored. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part light breeze hove up anchor and lowered 2 boats started the works.

Thursday June 22nd

First part commenced with fresh breeze and pleasant ^{weather} at dark anchored. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze. at daylight hove up anchor and lowered 2 boats. finished boiling. broke out shocks.

Friday June 23rd

First part commenced with moderate breeze and partly clear weather. at dark anchored on shalms oak. saw 1 bark. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part moderate breeze and cloudy. hove up the anchor and lowered 3 boats.

Saturday June 24th

First part commenced with moderate breeze gannet with the Jane Martin. at sundown anchored. Middle part light breeze. Latter part calm hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats.

Humpbacking

Sunday June 25th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and clear weather saw the Grace Marks boiling at sundown anchored. Middle part light breeze. Latter part fresh breeze and cloudy lowered 3 boats. hove up anchor.

Monday June 26th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and cloudy weather. the Bow Boat struck a Whale and after being fast awhile lost him at sundown anchored. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats. the Starboard Boat struck a Whale and the Starboard Boat struck another Whale.

Tuesday June 27th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and cloudy weather. killed the Whales and took them alongside. anchored the ship and got supper. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze. cut the Whales in.

Wednesday June 28th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and cloudy weather. employed in cutting up blubber started the works. Middle part boiling. Latter part cloudy lowered 2 boats the Starboard boat struck a Whale but the horn drewed and we lost him.
